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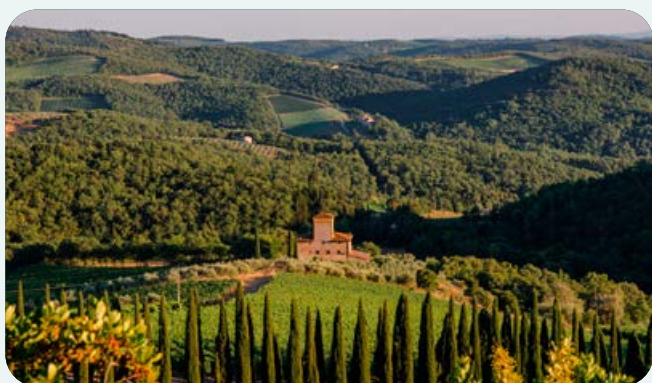

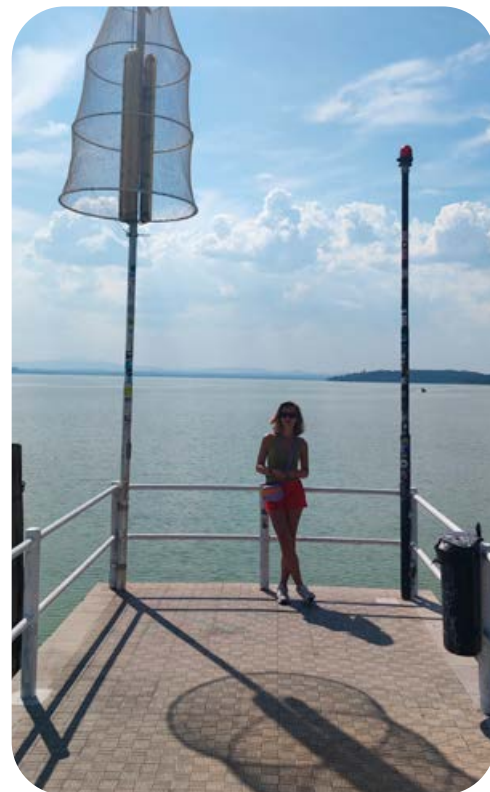
Lake Trasimeno: A hidden gem

scenery far from busy roads. Be sure to stop in Castiglione del Lago and visit its impressive castle. You can walk all the way around the castle walls for breathtaking views of the lake. For lunch, head to Passignano, a village I have fond memories of, as the campsite I visited as a child was nearby. The cozy village square is home to excellent trattorias where you can indulge in delicious Italian cuisine. After lunch, take a short walk up to La Rocca, an ancient fortress dating back to the 5th or 6th century.

Simply soaking in the Italian lifestyle here is a delight. The narrow alleys and medieval houses immerse you in the holiday spirit, and the aroma of fresh pasta and other delicacies fills the air. Don't resist the temptation to treat yourself to a plate of truffle ravioli—a true Umbrian specialty.

Luxury without frills

A visit to Lake Trasimeno wouldn't be complete without exploring its surrounding area. Umbria offers a wealth of culture, nature, and hidden gems. One of my favorite trips was to the city of Perugia. This vibrant city, where you can take escalators to reach the upper town

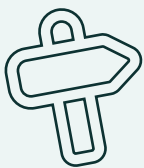
(a fun experience for kids!), is filled with lively squares, stunning viewpoints, and charming (food) shops inviting you to stroll and soak up the Italian lifestyle.

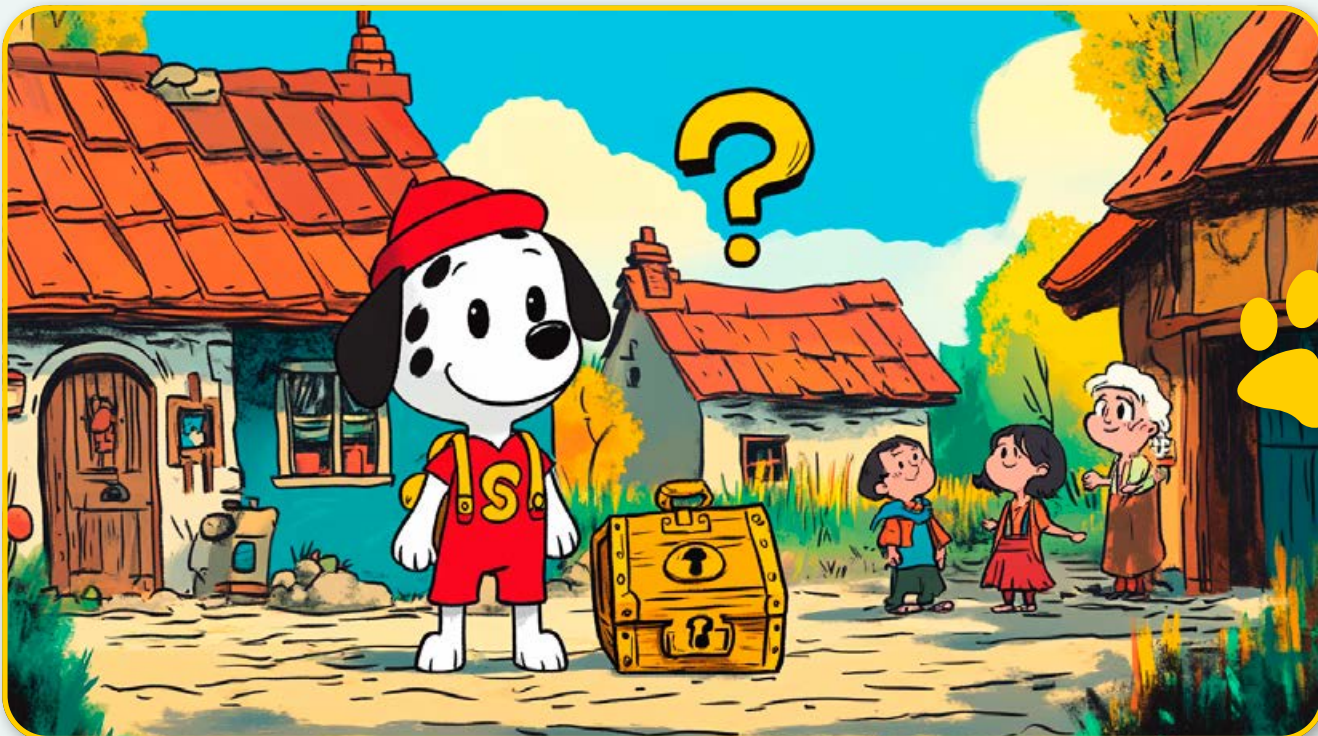

Spotty can't wait to embark on new adventures with you. Maybe you'll discover a new treasure together... or go on an exploration around the Glamping!





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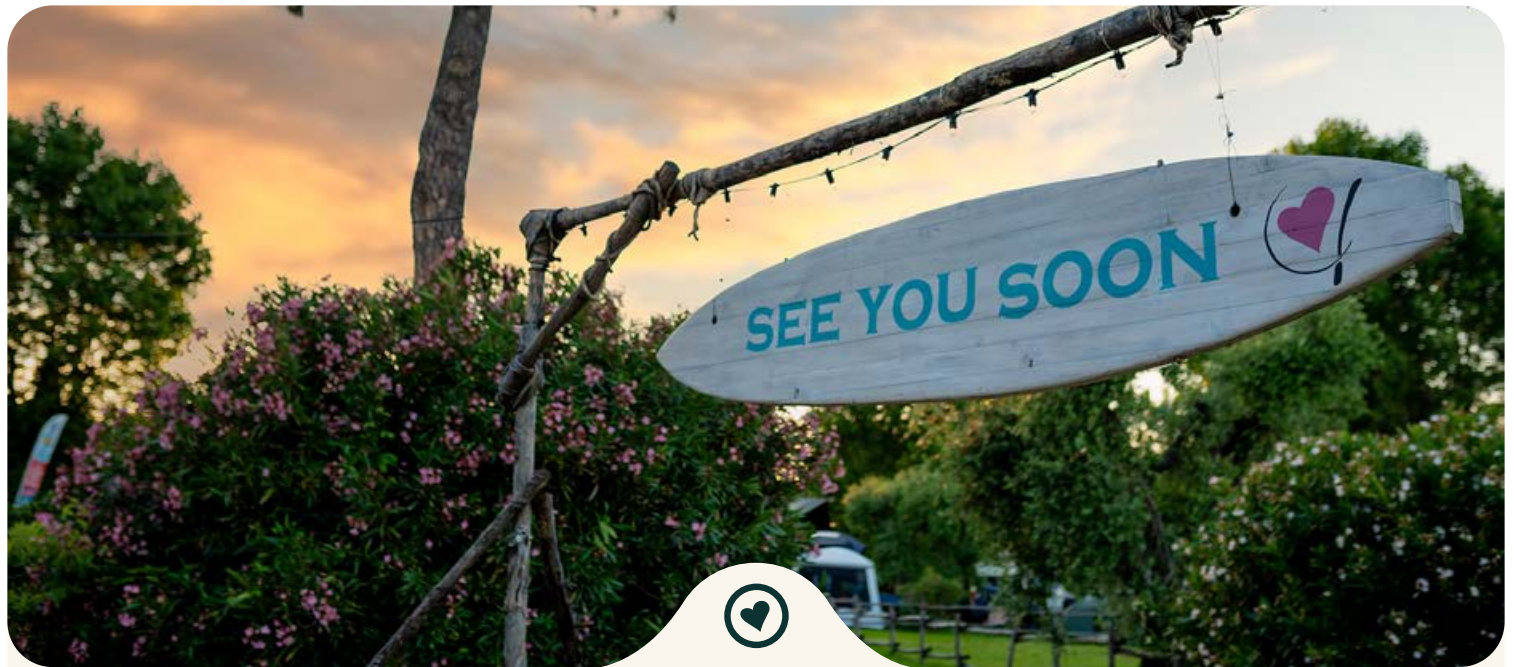

Can you briefly introduce yourself?

"I'm Wouter, the owner of TwenteFruit in Noord Deurningen (Denekamp) since 2018. Together with my girlfriend, our dog Duco, and my parents, we ensure that visitors have a unique experience picking their own fruit and enjoying the great outdoors."

How did TwenteFruit come to life?

"TwenteFruit started in 2018, but the farm has been in our family since 1966. My grandparents began farming here after the land consolidation, running a mixed farm with dairy cows, pigs, and chickens. In 2011, my father stopped livestock farming. I started searching for a new direction and discovered my passion for growing raspberries and blackberries. After a trial period, I began cultivating fruit on one hectare in 2018. Today, we also grow strawberries, blueberries, and since 2024, we've added a flower-picking garden and picnic baskets. We're constantly evolving and have many plans to enhance our guests' experience. Each year, we aim to introduce something new to provide the enjoyment our visitors deserve and expect."

What can visitors pick at TwenteFruit?

"During the season, visitors can pick raspberries, blackberries, blueberries, and strawberries. Any leftover fruit is used to make jam, juice, chutney, and smoothies, ensuring minimal waste."

How do you make your liqueurs?

"Another product we create from our fruit is our liqueurs. For this, we use only fresh fruit from our own harvest. The fruit is soaked in alcohol for a period of time to allow the flavors to infuse fully. We then process this aromatic alcohol further to craft our delicious liqueurs."



What's your favorite product?

"That's a tough question because I love all our products. If I had to choose, I'd say the smoothie! It's the best way to enjoy the full flavor of the fruit in a refreshing treat. After a day in the sun, there's nothing better than a smoothie packed with fresh fruit."

What can visitors do at TwenteFruit?

"It's all about the experience—picking fruit and enjoying the tranquility of the countryside. From mid-June, we open on weekends as the fruit begins to ripen, and we're open daily in July and August. We close again in September. Starting in 2025, we hope to open earlier with new activities, so keep an eye on our website and social media!"



Do you have a tip for a delicious recipe?

"One of my favorites that people often overlook is chutney. Try our raspberry-onion chutney or raspberry-chili chutney (if you like a spicy kick) with grilled chicken breast. It's simple and delicious! Season the chicken with salt and pepper, grill it, and add a generous spoonful of chutney. Enjoy your meal!"





‘Tuscany ROADTRIPPER’S PARADISE’

With its cypress trees, rolling hills, and romantic villages, Tuscany is a dream destination for any traveler. A road trip through this Italian region feels like driving through a postcard: breathtaking, timeless, and steeped in history. Avoid major roads and instead choose winding country lanes that pass vineyards and ancient towns—you’ll constantly be surprised. Travel blogger Marloes de Hooe takes you along the ultimate route to discover the most beautiful spots in Tuscany.

Tuscany always feels like coming home. It’s the mix of warmth and a relaxed pace of life that feels so familiar. My favorite thing about Tuscany is the mornings: when the soft rays of sunlight break through, you know another perfect day is ahead.

There are so many stunning places within reach that you might feel a bit of FOMO. But there’s no need for that—Tuscany will wait. Whatever you miss now, you can save for your next holiday.

Practical tips for the road:

- Avoid highways and follow the *strade bianche*, the unpaved chalk roads that lead you through the heart of Tuscany.
- A week or two is ideal: it gives you plenty of time to see a lot and relax at beautiful campsites.

- Spring and autumn are the best times to visit. But don’t let the summer crowds deter you—if that’s your only option, you’ll still have a fantastic time.

Start your journey in Florence

Tuscany is home to many “bucket list cities,” places you must visit at least once. Pisa, Siena, and certainly Florence. Known for its many art museums, Florence is, in fact, a masterpiece in itself. Simply wandering through the city is a delight. Florence is romantic, photogenic, atmospheric, and lively.

The Galleria degli Uffizi is considered one of the world’s most important art museums, featuring works by great artists such as Leonardo da Vinci, Michelangelo, Botticelli, and Raphael. The Duomo is not only Florence’s emblem

but also its central landmark. You can climb the Duomo’s dome (463 steps) for a stunning view of the city—highly recommended! For the best panoramic view of Florence, head to Piazza Michelangelo. This square on the city’s edge, perched on a hill, offers a sweeping view of Florence’s famous skyline.

Take the Chiantigiana (SR 222)

An unusual combination, but in Tuscany, it’s inevitable: road-tripping and wine tasting. Along this route, you’ll find countless vineyards. Many wineries are located along the Chiantigiana (SR 222), a road cutting through the Chianti Classico wine region. But where should you stop?

Castello di Albola is a stunning medieval castle that’s worth a visit even without



tasting its wine. It's the perfect spot to sample a Chianti Classico. In contrast, the ultramodern winery Antinori offers a completely different experience. It's one of the region's most famous wineries, producing wine for over 600 years, passed down through generations.

Brave the summer heat and climb the narrow spiral stairs of Torre del Mangia for the best view of the city. At 88 meters, it's the third tallest tower in Italy. The climb is steep, but the breathtaking panorama at the top is worth every step.

TIP:

A perfect base for exploring the Chianti region is Chianti Glamping Resort. Castello di Albola is just a short drive away. This unique park is nestled in lush greenery, with accommodations tucked among pine trees—ideal for shade during Tuscany's hot summers. Don't miss the Glamping Collection, where you can sleep in a vintage American school bus or Airstream!

Stunning Siena

One of Tuscany's most beloved destinations, Siena is known for its beautiful squares and ancient churches. The white-and-pink marble Duomo of Siena is one of Italy's must-see landmarks. The pedestrian-friendly town is compact and perfect for wandering through its maze of narrow streets. Siena's charm is no secret—its historic center is a UNESCO World Heritage site. Arrive early to beat the crowds.



Relax by the sea

Tuscany isn't typically known for its beaches, but ending your road trip by the sea is a perfect choice.

Follow a route past the hot springs of Saturnia—a unique open-air “spa”—to the picturesque harbor town of Talamone. The surrounding landscape is a haven for kite surfers and nature enthusiasts. Nearby is Maremma National Park, best explored on foot.

A bit further north, you'll find Torre Mozza. From this beach, you can see the island of Elba off the coast. Boats to Elba depart from the village of Scarlino, just a short drive away, if you'd like to add the island to your trip.

TIP:

A 15-minute drive from Torre Mozza takes you to Vallicella Glamping Resort. Built on terraces in the hills, the park offers plenty of privacy and stunning natural views. Situated in an olive grove, the resort even produces its own olive oil. And don't miss the pool—it boasts the longest slide in Italy!





PASTA AL POMODORO

A classic Pasta Pomodoro,
perfect for a simple and authentic summer meal!

Preparation Time: 10 minutes | Cooking Time: 20 minutes | Servings: 4

Ingredients:

- 400 g Tagliatelle Trefilate all'uovo (available via our webshop)
- 500 g ripe tomatoes (preferably San Marzano or Roma)
- 2 garlic cloves, minced
- 4 tbsp extra virgin olive oil
- 1 onion
- 1 bunch of fresh basil
- Salt and pepper to taste
- Parmesan cheese, freshly grated (optional)

Instructions:

1. Dice the tomatoes and onion into small cubes. Heat the olive oil in a large skillet over medium heat. Add the minced garlic and onion and sauté for 1–2 minutes until fragrant but not browned.
2. Add the diced tomatoes and season with salt and pepper. Let the sauce simmer gently for 15 minutes until the tomatoes are soft and the sauce has thickened slightly. Stir occasionally.
3. Meanwhile, cook the pasta in a large pot of salted water according to the package instructions, until al dente.
4. Drain the pasta and add it to the pan with the tomato sauce. Add a few fresh basil leaves and a drizzle of extra virgin olive oil. Mix well.
5. Serve the pasta warm, garnished with extra fresh basil and, if desired, freshly grated Parmesan cheese.

Chef's tip:

For an extra layer of flavor, add a pinch of dried chili flakes to the sauce for a subtle spiciness. Buon Appetito!

Preparation time: 20 minutes | Rising time: 2 hours | Baking time: 35 minutes | Servings: 1 large loaf

Ingredients:

- 500 g wheat flour
- 250 ml lukewarm milk
- 75 g butter, melted
- 75 g brown sugar
- 2 tsp cinnamon
- 1 packet (7 g) dried yeast
- 200 g currants
- 100 g raisins
- 1 egg
- Pinch of salt

For garnish:

- Extra milk for brushing
- Knob of butter for serving

Instructions:

1. Soak the currants and raisins in lukewarm water for 15 minutes. Drain and pat dry with paper towels.
2. In a large bowl, combine the flour, yeast, brown sugar, cinnamon, and a pinch of salt. Add the lukewarm milk, egg, and melted butter.
3. Knead the mixture into a smooth dough (about 10 minutes). Knead in the currants and raisins until evenly distributed.
4. Shape the dough into a ball. Place it in a bowl, cover with a damp tea towel, and let it rise in a warm place for 1.5 hours, until doubled in size.
5. Knead the dough briefly and shape it into a long loaf. Place it on a baking sheet lined with parchment paper. Cover and let it rise for another 30 minutes.
6. Preheat the oven to 200°C (390°F).
7. Brush the loaf with a little milk for a glossy finish. Bake the krentenwegge in the center of the oven for 30–35 minutes until golden brown. Let it cool on a wire rack.
8. Serve in thick slices with a generous layer of butter. Enjoy!

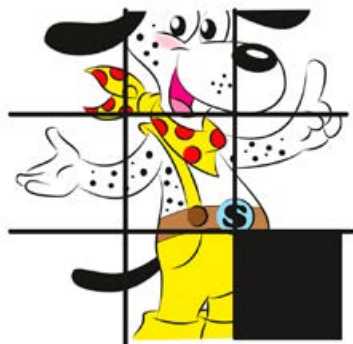
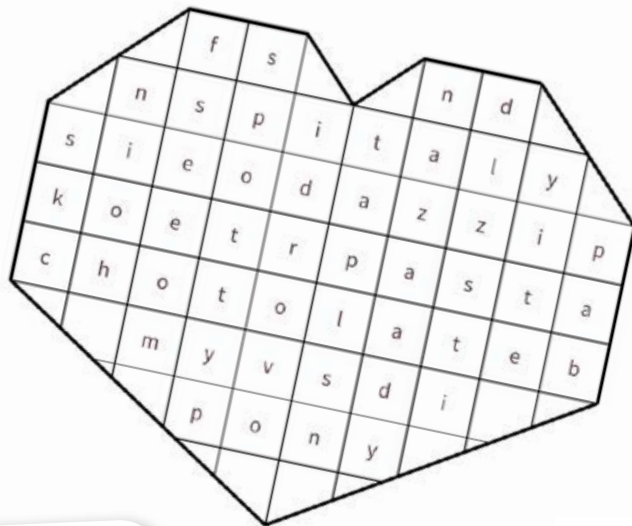

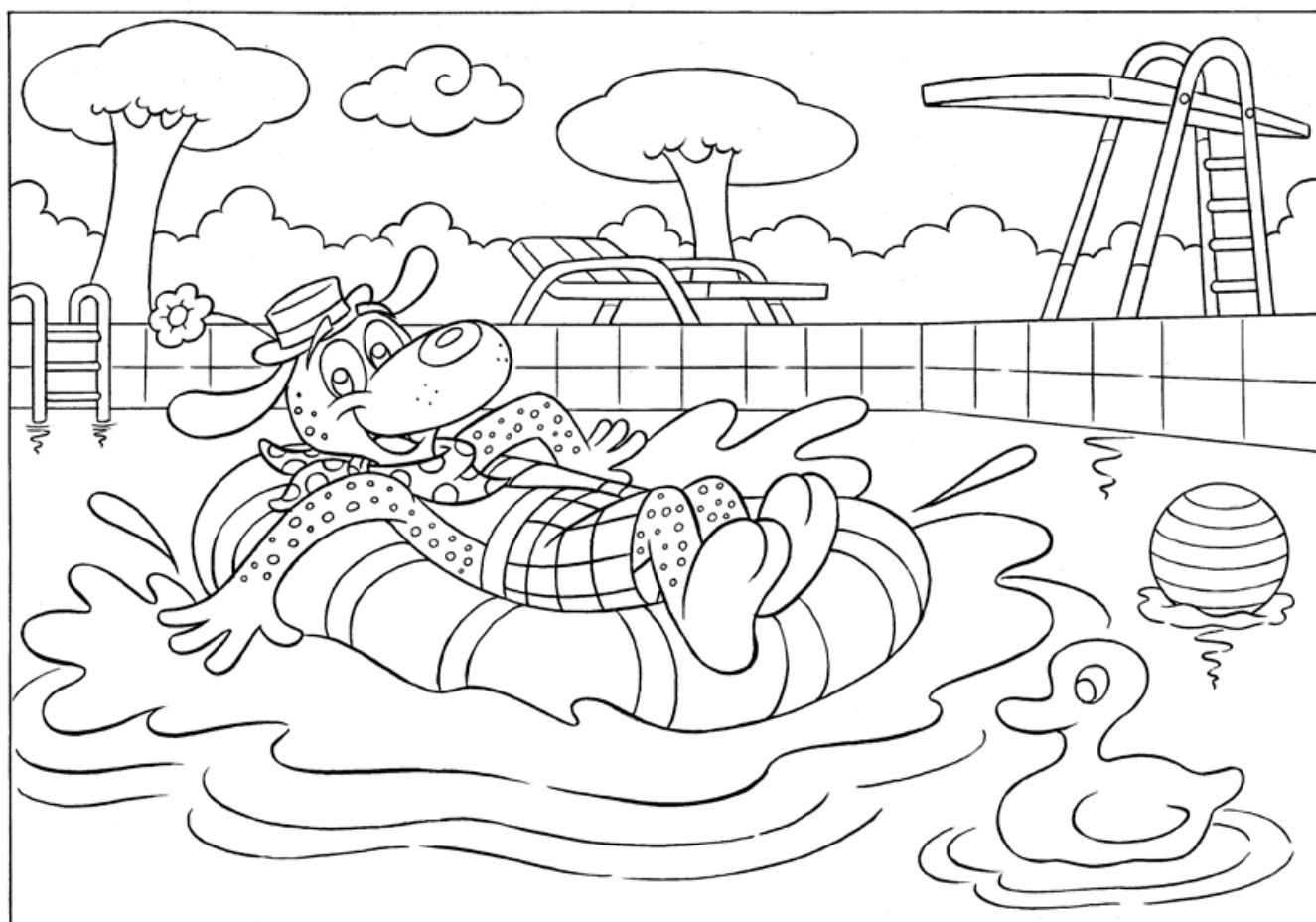

LIVE LIKE A LOCAL

Italian customs and travel tips

You've packed your bags, put on your sunglasses, and practiced your best Ciao! in the mirror. You're ready for Italy! But wait... before you dive headfirst into la dolce vita, there are a few crucial things you need to know to avoid being immediately recognized as a tourist. Italians have a sixth sense for that. Luckily, we've put together some tips (with a wink) to help you travel through Italy like a true local.



1. When to drink cappuccino?

Italians take their coffee seriously. Very seriously. And while you might think a cappuccino is a good idea at any time of day, an Italian will look at you as if you just suggested ordering a pineapple pizza (we'll get to that in a minute). The rule is simple: cappuccino is only for the morning, ideally before 11:00 AM. After that, it's espresso time. Why? Because cappuccino is considered part of breakfast.

2. Pizza with fruit?

Let's make this clear right away: according to Italians, pineapple does not belong on pizza. If you order a Hawaiian pizza in an Italian restaurant, they might suggest you book a flight home immediately. Italians love their culinary traditions, and fruit on pizza is seen as an attack on their cultural heritage. However, because Italians are hospitable to tourists, they (begrudgingly) include Hawaiian pizza on the menu. So, as a tourist, you can still order it—just expect some side-eye.

3. Hand gestures: The Italian morse code

You've probably seen it before—Italians talking with intense hand movements. This is no coincidence; it's an essential part of Italian communication. Here are a few basic gestures you should know:



- **The fingers pinched together and raised** (*"Ma che vuoi?"*) – Means: "What are you doing?!"
- **Brushing the hand under the chin** (*"Non me ne frega!"*) – Means: "I don't care."
- **Two fingers under one eye** (*"Occhio!"*) – Means: "Watch out, be careful!"

If you really want to blend in, try pairing your words with some strategic hand movements.

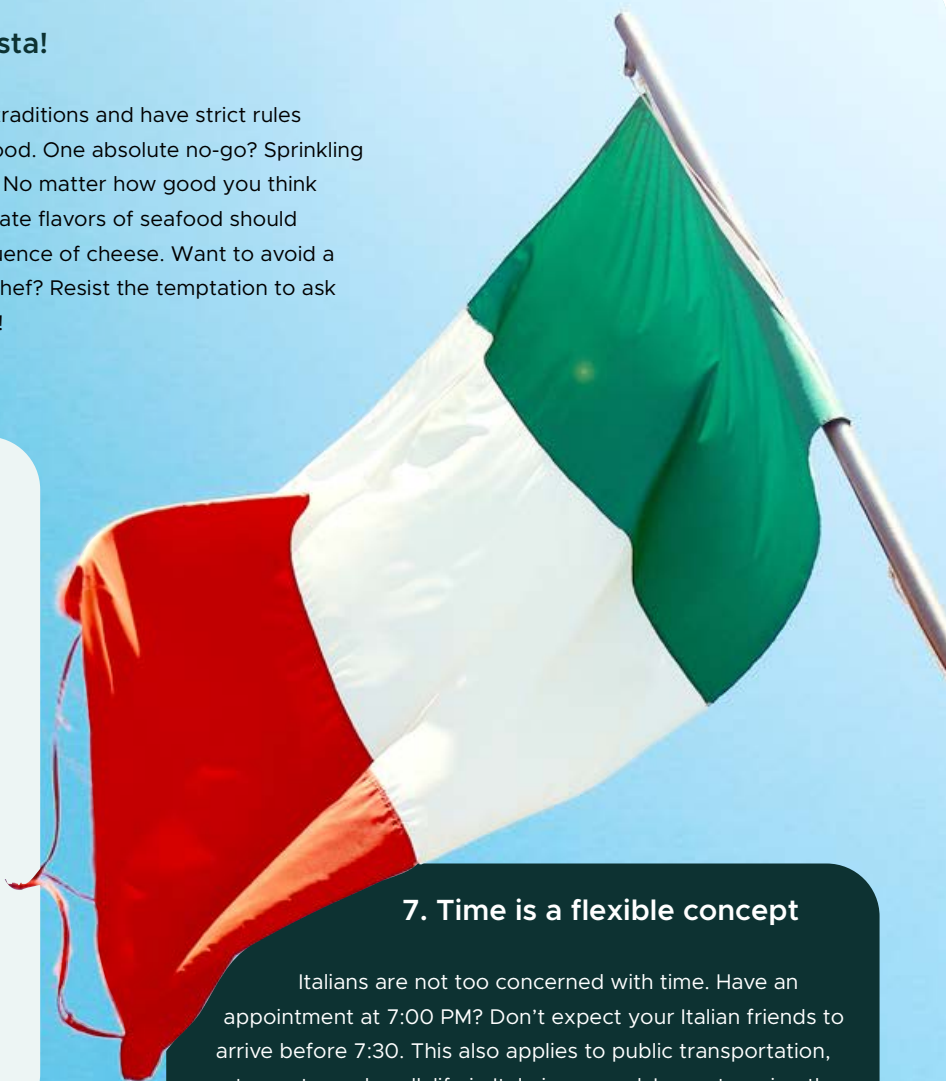
4. No parmesan on seafood pasta!

Italians are passionate about their culinary traditions and have strict rules about what can and cannot be done with food. One absolute no-go? Sprinkling Parmesan cheese on seafood or fish pasta. No matter how good you think it tastes, it's considered sacrilege. The delicate flavors of seafood should remain pure, without the overpowering influence of cheese. Want to avoid a disapproving look from your waiter or the chef? Resist the temptation to ask for cheese with your spaghetti alle vongole!



5. Fashion? Always a serious matter

Italian fashion is no joke. Even if Italians are just heading out to buy bread, they still look like they're on their way to a Milan fashion show. Sneakers or sandals with white socks? No, no, no. Sweatpants? Only if you're actually jogging. Want to avoid standing out? Wear stylish sunglasses and make sure your shoes are impeccable. Italians always check your shoes first—really.



7. Time is a flexible concept

Italians are not too concerned with time. Have an appointment at 7:00 PM? Don't expect your Italian friends to arrive before 7:30. This also applies to public transportation, restaurants, and, well, life in Italy in general. Learn to enjoy the moment and embrace the relaxed pace.

6. The language of La Dolce Vita

It's always handy to know a few Italian words and phrases. Here's a little cheat sheet:

- **Ciao!** <tjsaao> – Hello/bye (informal only!)
- **Buongiorno!** <bwohn-djorn-no> – Good morning
- **Grazie!** <graat-tsje> – Thank you
- **Prego!** <pre-go> – You're welcome
- **Scusi!** <skoe-zie> – Excuse me
- **Dov'è il bagno?** <do-veh il ban-jo> – Where is the bathroom?
- **Un caffè, per favore.** <oen kaf-feh, per fa-vo-re> – An espresso, please (yes, a caffè means espresso!)
- **Il conto, per favore.** <il kon-to, per fa-vo-re> – The bill, please

8. The proper order of an Italian meal

In Italy, you don't just eat everything all at once. A traditional meal follows a specific structure. Want to eat like a true Italian? Stick to this order:



1. **Antipasto** – A small appetizer, like bruschetta, olives, or prosciutto.
2. **Primo** – The first course, usually pasta, risotto, or soup.
3. **Secondo** – The main course, which consists of meat or fish (usually served without a side dish).
4. **Contorno** – A side dish, such as vegetables or salad (ordered separately with your secondo).
5. **Dolce** – Dessert! Think tiramisu, panna cotta, or gelato.
6. **Caffè** – An espresso to finish the meal (no cappuccino!).
7. **Digestivo** – A liqueur like limoncello or grappa to help with digestion.
